Our October 16th, gathering at the Boathouse Restaurant, was a success! It was an honor to have Dave Wick, Executive Director of Lake George Park Commission as our quest speaker. He presented us with a very informative PowerPoint slideshow on the "State of Lake George". Although many of us have been on the lake most of our lives, we were intrigued by some of the information he reported, regarding the lake itself. Among many things he reported, the Park Commission registered over 16,000 boats this year, the highest amount since 1999. With that being said, the inspection sites passed through over 30,000 boats, finding 69 of those boats having an invasive species, down from last vear when 129 where found to have carried invasive onboard. He took the time to answer many questions at the end regarding different bays, buoys, (PWC) jetski's and safety. Wick was asked how long can NYS continue these inspection sites. His answer was "as long as the state can continue to fund them". Kudos to the great efforts for keeping our lake beautiful! We have soared to the top of the list for the cleanest lake in the US. Wick did insure us as always the most important thing on the lake is safety. The Park Commission is currently working with rental marinas to establish new safety regulations for the 2017 season. In closing he stated, the Park Commission is always open for ideas.

Lastly, we want to thank the Boathouse Restaurant who did a wonderful job accommodating us and our speaker and as always, we all enjoyed a great meal with a view. I personally would like to thank everyone that participated; it is "your participation" that made this afternoon a success and it was greatly appreciated! We want the holidays to be enjoyable with family & friends, they are very important! Therefore as of now we are planning our next gathering mid-January and will keep you posted.
