A new regulation, the next phase of a 2019 law known as Brianna's Law, took effect at the first of this year. Under this new phase, those born on or after January 1, 1978, who want to operate a power boat will need a safety certificate. That law now applies to anyone 46 years or younger. In 2025, all operators regardless of age will need the certificate. If you know someone who has yet to complete the boater certification course, please ask that they contact our Squadron Education Officer, P/C Donna Canestraro, S at (518) 372-7220. Donna will be happy to provide all the information needed to complete the course and exam.

As we each begin the new boating season let's not forget all the things that make boating fun and safe for everyone on the water. Be sure to get your vessel safety check by contacting Armand (see note below).

We also should be thinking about what you can do to help the Squadron through your service - how about helping teach a course or serving on a committee (or even the Bridge)? and we should always be seeking out new members - talk it up, invite a friend to join us. P/C Canestraro while this past weekend performing Vessel Safety Checks landed a potential new member for the Squadron. It's that easy, you too can bring in new members!

Note that the registration decal must be displayed on the vessel and a receipt is not a valid substitution. If you need your registration immediately, you should buy it in person at our office, or one of the many local vendors around the lake.
